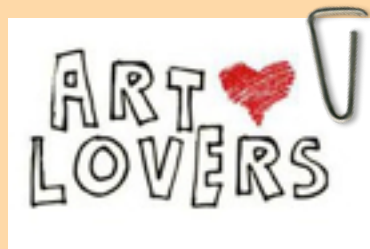

**ORDINANCE REMINDERS FOR SPRING**

Sec. 4-258. - Authorization required to cut or damage any public tree.

No person, including public utilities, shall do any of the following acts to any public tree unless authorized by the city horticulturist:

- (1) Cut, prune, climb with spikes, break, damage, remove, kill or cause to be killed.
- (2) Cut, disturb or interfere in any way with any root within the drip line.
- (3) Place, or spray with, any toxic chemical as listed in the maintenance standards.
- (4) Fasten any rope, wire, sign or other device.
- (5) Remove or damage any guard device placed to protect any tree.
- (6) Maintain a stationary fire or device which vaporizes noxious fumes harmful to tree health.
- (7) Pave with concrete, asphalt or other impervious material within five feet of a tree

Florence City and/or Timrod Park Historic area, on public OR private property, the resident will be issued a written citation:
