MINUTES

November 1, 2011

1. Alicia Connelly, TPNA president, welcomed everyone to the meeting, which was held at the Jeffers Center.
2. The monthly police report was not given
3. The financial report was given by the Secretary-Treasurer. There is \$ 989.83 in the account. Steve Powers [S/W Printing] has made our neighborhood meeting signs and these were placed out for today's meeting. An invoice has not been sent to us at this time.
4. Alicia discussed a number of issues: A zoning update was given on the property on Coit St. The B1 to B2 change would allow development that we do not want. At this point, it will go before City Council again on November 14. We were all encouraged to write letters, call, or email Council. Some of us will be at the next Council meeting to voice our concerns. It was stressed that the more opposition that could be shown, the greater the chance it can be defeated.
Some of us will be meeting with the City Manager, Drew Griffin, on 11/3/11 to discuss our concerns about our neighborhood.
The police chief has called a meeting with neighborhood representatives to discuss community problems. Alicia asked for volunteers to attend. A couple of neighbors indicated interest and they will meet after the meeting with Alicia.
5. Concerns were raised about the KA house on the corner of McQueen and Cedar. Specific problems involved very loud and vulgar noise and fighting in the street. There was discussion as to how to get some help. Suggestions included making sure police reports were filed, calling the police every time a violation occurred, a letter to FMU Student Affairs V-P and/or FMU president, as well as sending a letter with specific incidents to the KA fraternity headquarters.
6. There was a discussion about a Christmas party but this was not resolved. In the past we have had a "drop in" in lieu of a regular December meeting
7. Meeting was adjourned with the next meeting scheduled for December 1, 2011, at 7PM at the Jeffers Center.
